The focus of this document is to show a strategic plan for PNBC Missions for at least the next four years. It will show the planning of the PNBC Missions Ministry for the parent body, and how it is executed and articulated among our churches at the local, state, regional and international levels. The charge that our current constitution and by-laws puts forth for the Missions Department states:



“Article V - Section 11. Progressive National Baptist Convention Mission Ministry shall be responsible for the supervision and operation of the Convention’s International and National Mission Program. This responsibility includes a convention-wide program on National and International Ministries, promotion of the general budget of the Convention, and planning and executing special financial drives for Missions. 11a. All Mission projects, fundraising promotions, and mission endeavors promoted by the Convention’s Boards, Commissions, Institutions, Departments, Auxiliaries, Associations and other member entities, must be endorsed and monitored by and held accountable to the Progressive National Baptist Convention Mission Ministry. (Amended August 9, 2001)”

Consistent with this responsibility, we present this plan, beginning with our overall mandate:



OVERALL MANDATE

The PNBC Missions Ministry is a vibrant, empowering, impactful, and holistic, 21st Century mission movement in the spirit of our convention.

This will be accomplished as follows:



THE PNBC MISSIONS MINISTRY HAS A VIBRANT, EMPOWERING, AND HOLISTIC MINISTRY DOMESTICALLY

OBJECTIVE 1: COLLABORATION WITH OTHER DEPARTMENTS WITHIN PNBC IN DOING MISSIONS. We will work with all departments, committees, boards, and agencies of PNBC involving missions work.

- Contact of PNBC departments, regions, agencies, and committees
- Beginning of constructing collaborative projects.



THE PNBC MISSIONS MINISTRY HAS A VIBRANT, EMPOWERING, AND HOLISTIC MINISTRY DOMESTICALLY

OBJECTIVE 2: COLLABORATION WITH PNBC CHURCHES IN DOING MISSIONS. Working with individual churches, and giving support, when appropriate, to their mission projects on a denominational level

- Contact of churches identified as doing independent mission work from PNBC
- Beginning and execution of potential collaborative projects.

- Create a mutually agreed upon approach to regional missions
- Identify initial projects
